Iwona Kutnik – a fashion designer born in Lublin. She graduated from the Technical School of Clothing in Lublin and the School of Art and Fashion Design in Kraków. She made her debut at the age of 17 with her collection of the Young Polish Designers Gala, “Prowokacje” (“Provocations”). She participated in many prestigious fashion shows, including “Iglą Malowane” (“Painted with needles”), Poznań Fashion Week and the Lublin Fashion Gala. Her collections and individual projects have been mentioned for many years in the press, on television and on the web. She gathered vocational experience by working for several Polish clothing companies, including LPP of Gdańsk, where she designed clothing for such brands as Reserved and Cropp.

Since 2006 she has been running her own clothing design workshop. Iwona Kutnik’s Studio is currently located in a historic tenement house in the Lublin city centre at Staszica 10, apartment 13.

Her creations are characterised by high quality of workmanship, modern pattern design and unique form. She has gained the trust of women who value the extraordinarily feminine character of her projects and the professional and individual approach to each of them.
